The generally west to north westerly winds 20 to 20 knots but winds becoming north to nor east 5 to 15 knots near Bicheno this afternoon with local afternoon sea breezes to 15 knots in shore. West to north west winds 10 to 20 knots with a chance of in shore afternoon sea breezes in the Derwent Estuary during the afternoon. Winds well south of Tasman Island locally reaching north west at 20 to 25 1 to 2 metre seas in open waters. 2 to 2.5 metre south to south east swell.
